Due to the nature of the economy, we maintained reduced prices since the previous year. Elementary Camp Cost is \$300 per Camper (approx. \$50/day). Grades 2 - 7, the grade entering in the fall. First week of Camp is limited to 85 Campers. No Walk-on Registrations at KoBaWoo, or at Camp. Speaker is Ms. Karen Boorse.  
**Note** Children who have not attended a year of elementary school (those entering 1st grade in Fall, 2009) tend to have difficulty with homesickness at an overnight Camp lasting a week. Even if older siblings attend, we will ask Campers who have not attended the 1st grade to wait another year. In addition, those who have difficulty understanding English may have difficulty following the Program and its education; please consider waiting one year before registering your child for Camp.

Due to the nature of today's economy, we, again, did not raise prices from the previous year. Our Youth Camp cost is \$310 per Camper (approx. \$44/day). Grades 8 - 12, the grade entering in the fall. Second week is limited to 90 Campers. No Walk-on Registration at KoBaWoo, or at Camp. The Speaker is Rev. Jack Hager (entering his 20th year). Campers should be entering at least the 8th grade in September, and, at most, entering College in August. Those who have difficulty understanding English may have difficulty following the Program and its education; please consider waiting one year before registering your child for Camp.

**registrations**

**We require you to send in your Registration Deposit of \$50 by July 18.** The Registration Deposit is part of your total payment for Camp; if you send in \$50, you only need to pay the balance of \$250 for the First Week (or \$260, if Second Week) by the Sunday (1st day) of Camp.

This Registration Deposit will be refundable, if notifying the team by Sunday, July 12th. There may be a late fee of \$20 added to the Camp Cost, if Registration (with no Registration Deposit) is postmarked after Saturday, July 18th. For Children and Youth of Pastors and Jundosanim, the cost is \$250 per Camper for either week (children or youth). For those needing additional financial support, please email or call, as we would like to work out all possibilities for your child to attend. Please do not let finances prevent your child from attending our Camp; contact a member of our team to discuss any possibilities.

**Camper Participation Resolution**

The Gospel orders unconditional love to be shown in a Gospel-centered ministry (if we were to err in this ministry of grace and truth, PFC desires to err on the side of grace). Yet, to those who have consistently been churched and exposed to the Gospel, and have not responded to the Gospel, and seem merely desirous of exploiting a Gospel-environment such as ours, we have determined that PFC's Camp shall not be a gracious harbor to licentious play (Matthew 7:6). Camp will not merely be a playground for those with little desire to participate and cooperate in our Program (potentially spoiling the experiences of others); after all, the local church is certainly more equipped to address the year-round needs of our children and youth. PFC, as a para-church Camp ministry, is a time-sensitive ministry to those who register and participate. We are called to be discerning between those who would consider the message that PFC shares the Gospel, which is the person and work of Jesus and those who would disparage and belittle the whole of PFC's mission. For the most effective engagement of this Gospel ministry, we are called to discern the few who have and could be detrimental to the ministry for the whole, and thus, reserve the right to ask those, according to our careful examination, not to participate or return.

Churches can attend/participate as a group, yet each Camper should fill out a separate Registration form (please feel free to register online at [www.pfc.us](http://www.pfc.us), or mail in a completed Registration form attached to this brochure). Each Registration should represent one individual. **Please (1)** fill out, and submit this Registration form, or complete a Registration form online (as soon as possible), and **(2)** submit the Camper's deposit (by July 18th) or payment in full, for Camp. This is the only way you can be guaranteed of your place as a Camper this summer at Camp. **To Contact Us** (the Administrators of Camp), please call Ms. Sally Lee (in Korean) at (484) 744-4827, or Ms. Benica Kim (in English) at (856) 287-3372, or email us anytime at [questions@pfc.us](mailto:questions@pfc.us) with any concerns or questions. **Departure and Arrival** is at KoBaWoo Korean Super Market in the rear parking area, on Cheltenham Avenue in Elkins Park, PA. **Directions:** From the corner of Cheltenham Ave and Route 611 (Old York Road), go 1 mile (approx.) on Cheltenham Avenue towards Route 309 (it will appear on the right side). **From the junction:** of Cheltenham and Route 309 (Ogontz Avenue), it is 1 mile (approx.) on Cheltenham towards 5th Street (it will appear on the left side). **For directions to our rented Campsite** (Camp Men-O-Lan in Quakertown, PA), a map and detailed directions will be available on our website ([www.pfc.us](http://www.pfc.us)), or call/email. **We depart on Sunday afternoon at 4:00pm.** For both weeks, Campers are expected to arrive at 2:30pm at KoBaWoo for Confirmation of Registration. **The Camp Vans or Bus depart promptly at 4:00pm.** Our Program begins at 5pm at Camp. (Bus seating at KoBaWoo is limited, so we encourage parents and churches, if it is possible, to drop-off and pick-up your children at Camp directly. We would appreciate that). **Returning from Camp to KoBaWoo on the First Week** (elementary) is on Friday (August 7), or Second Week (youth) is on Saturday (August 15). **We return both weeks at 12:30pm to the KoBaWoo Market, rear parking area.**

As well, at no point is harassment or strong-arming condoned. In this grace-driven environment, the strong will not take advantage of the weak (grace forgives the repentant; while there is justice for those who trample on grace). PFC will use our authority to preserve a safe, gracious environment for all to consider the Gospel of Jesus Christ.  
Hence PFC reserves the right to not accept the Registration of any particular individual based on their willingness to cooperate in our Program the previous year. PFC also reserves the right to release Campers at anytime during the time that they are at Camp, for not complying with our values, Program, or disruption of the Camp social dynamic.
